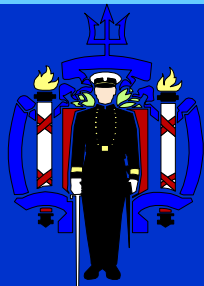

Directions to the Shouse Village Community Center:

From the Beltway (Route 495) to Dulles Toll Road (Route 267):

Take the Dulles Toll Road Route 267 West
Continue through the TOLL BOOTH (\$0.75)
Take Exit 15 Wolf Trap Farm Park
Pass Wolf Trap Farm Park on your right. Continue on Trap Road ¼ mile.
Road name changes to Towlston Road.
Make Second Left onto Shouse Drive.
Immediately turn Left into parking lot.
Community Center is on the corner of Shouse Drive and Towlston Drive.

From the Beltway (Route 495) to Leesburg Pike (Route 7):

Take Leesburg Pike Route 7 West toward Tyson's Corner and Leesburg.
Turn Left on Towlston Road (about 3 miles on Route 7).
Make First Right onto Shouse Drive.
Immediately turn Left into parking lot.
Community Center is on the corner of Shouse Drive and Towlston Drive.
